NOTICE OF THE ACADEMIC STANDARDS THAT ARE IN EFFECT
FOR THE 2016-2017 SCHOOL YEAR

The Gillett School District is committed to providing a high quality education that promotes well-rounded and life-long learners. At the Board of Education held July 21, 2016, the Board was informed that the Common Core State Standards, Next Generation Science Standards, Wisconsin Model Academic Standards, and Wisconsin Model Early Learning Standards are the curriculum standards to be used in the Gillett School District as required under Wisconsin State Statute 120.12(13).

The Gillett School District has adopted the Common Core State Standards (CCSS) for Language Arts, Disciplinary Literacy, and Math, and we are currently implementing the Next Generation Science Standards (NGSS) in Science.

The District also implements the Wisconsin Model Academic Standards in Social Studies and all related arts area including Music, Art, Physical Education, Health Education, Foreign Language, Family and Consumer Education, Agriculture Education, Business Education, and Technology Education. The District implements Wisconsin Model Early Learning Standards for students in Early Childhood.

We believe that children learn in different ways and therefore have made a commitment to offer individualized learning opportunities to meet the varied needs of our students. All students are universally screened in grades K-12, and the results of these exams are used to identify students who may need additional support or those who need to be accelerated. Each school incorporates intervention time in their schedules to meet the needs of all students. The District is also using benchmark screenings, as well as ongoing summative and formative assessments to guide individual instruction.
